There will be an Officials meeting at approximately 12:30 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

Attention Horsemen: NSA car passes will allow for admission to the grounds by way of the Horseman's Gate #2. NSA horsemen pins allow horsemen access to the paddock and on Members Hill and the horsemen's hospitality tent. There will be a stable hospitality tent located in the stable area with beverages and food for grooms and horsemen that cannot leave the stable.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A "raised" toe is defined as an extension of the shoe that exceeds the highest continuous rim of the shoe by more than 1/16 inch. Stickers, caulks and "turn-downs" are not permitted. Shoes will be inspected before each race. Violations will result in a scratch.

Stalls will be provided - Special requests, contact Larry Smith (540) 822-9305.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary examination from 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. for all entries. Bandages must be removed.

No schooling on the racecourse due to course preparation. The course will be set and flagged by Thursday evening.

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months." The certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the grounds.

Horsemen's Enclosure Tent (adjacent to the Steward Stand) please come enjoy the official and horsemen's luncheon from 11:30 am until 2:00 pm. Horsemen are invited to the After Race Party at the Horsemen's Enclosure Tent following the last race.

Stable Hospitality Tent (East side of the Stable Tent) coffee, drinks, snacks and light fare will be provided all day for horsemen.

TURF - Besides the 5 inches of rain early in October, irrigation has continued and should end the middle of this week. The course was mowed on Saturday (10/9) at 6 1/2 inches.

SMOOTHNESS - Very smooth and has a thick mat of clippings.

COMPACTION - Most recent watering areas - 90-105 The rest of the course averaged 115 and will be watered again this week.

MOISTURE - 10

NOTES - Previously mentioned brown areas resulting from the drought kill show great germination of new seedlings. Most of these areas will be greenish with new grass with a thick mat.

Directions: All Gold Cup car passes have specific directions on the back -- please follow the directions for each specific Gate.

Directions for the Horsemen's Gate:

From Washington: Take I-66 West to Exit 43A onto Rt. 29 South for approximately 11 miles toward Warrenton. Take exit for Rt. 17 North toward Winchester for 8 miles to Old Tavern Road (also Rt. 245) on right. Do not join right hand lane on Rt. 17 waiting to enter Gate 8.

From Middleburg: West on Rt. 50 from Middleburg, then South on Zulla Road (also Rt. 709), then left on Rt. 17 South and left on Old Tavern Road (Rt. 245).

From Warrenton and South: North on Rt. 17, then right on Old Tavern Road (Rt. 245).

Proceed directly to Rt. 245, do not join in the right hand lane waiting to enter Gate 8 on Rt. 17.

From Leesburg: Take Rt. 15 South to I-66 West at Haymarket; take Exit 28 to Rt. 17 South, turn left on Rt. 845 (Old Winchester Road).
